- Count, read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.
- Count in multiples of twos and fives
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10/20.
- Add and subtract one digit and two digit numbers to 10/20, including zero using concrete materials.
- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.
- Solve one step problems such as missing number problems using pictorial representations.
