Homework is to be completed by Monday 9th December- we will celebrate all completed homework in class.

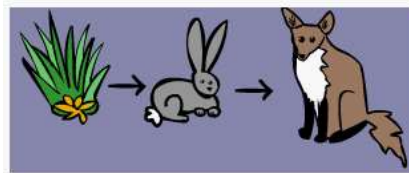
Alongside the learning challenge, weekly homework will include; spellings, regular reading and learning the 2, 5 and 10 time tables (Year 2 - Tackling Tables).

Write a book review about your favourite book.



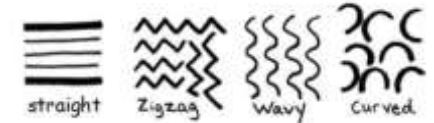
Create your own food chain.
