Diva lamp – a small, clay lamp lit at Divali

Guy Fawkes – the leader of the Gunpowder Plot

Gunpowder Plot – the plan to blow up the Houses of Parliament altar – the table at the front of a church

Translucent – something that is partly see through

Forecast – predicting what the weather will do

Meteorologist – someone who studies the weather

Seasons – 4 parts of the year

Celebration - people remember a special event or story

Traditions - things people have done for many years
